

Directions to OASES (Renovation version)



1. Use the main entrance off University City Boulevard (Route 49).



2. Take the first right out of the traffic circle onto Mary Alexander Road. You will pass Robinson Hall on the left.



3. East Deck 1 Visitors Parking will be on the right, park in this deck. Pass through the gate to receive a ticket. If there is no gate, it is the wrong parking deck. Parking is \$1/half-hour. Carry the ticket with you and use cash or credit to pay at the walk-up machine upon returning to the deck.



4. Leave the parking deck, cross Mary Alexander Road toward campus. Cato Hall is on the right. Take a right to walk in front of Cato and take your first left to walk past Fretwell, which will be on your right.



5. Behind Cato Hall and to the left of Fretwell is a lawn with the *Self-Made Man* statue.



6. Past the lawn, straight ahead, is a two-story brick building with a green barricade around the entrance. OASES is located on the first floor in room 106. Walk toward the building and take a right, then your first left, to walk around the backside of the building. You will take your first left and walk through the doors on your left that say Office of Adult Students and Evening Services. We are located past Veterans Services at the end of the hall. Travel time from the parking deck to the office is about 4-6 minutes.
