## 49ER FINISH PROGRAM

The 49er Finish Program recruits and assists former UNC Charlotte seniors with completing their degrees through personalized advising services. The program uses a concierge approach to advise students on readmission and re-enrollment requirements, general education, current academic policies and procedures, and connects them with the academic and campus resources.

## OTHER SERVICES

**Adult Mentoring Program for Students:** A peer mentoring program for adult student volunteers to connect with new students.

**Adult Student Orientation:** A great opportunity to get a jump start on what you need to know as an adult student!
